Today, I want you to change your thinking. The old mindset says: I can't have it. But the new mindset realizes: He's already provided it for me.

God has a new level of favor prepared for you!

It's more than you asked for, bigger than you've ever dreamed, and beyond comprehension. Favor in the classroom. Favor on the job. Favor for your children. Favor with a client. Favor in every endeavor!

I want you to know that the favor of God is coming your way in spite of your past, in spite of your problems, in spite of your pain, and in spite of your position. God doesn't give out His favor fairly, like wages being paid to laborers. Favor is given freely. In fact, I will say it this way: You can't explain the favor on your life because favor isn't fair.

Favor supersedes your past experiences!

The favor God gave Ruth was greater than anything she had ever known. Ruth had been through extreme difficulties; she had experience famine, destruction, poverty, and peril. But the depth of her past was an indication of the height of her future! God was releasing His powerful, behind-the-scenes, too-good-to-be-true, bigger-than-you-can-imagine FAVOR over her life. Ruth's story is your story too. Her redeemer, Boaz, was a shadow of Jesus. When Boaz redeemed Ruth and poured his love and provision over her, the Bible is giving us a picture of what happens in your life. Jesus has redeemed you and loves you unconditionally. He is pouring His love and provision over your life.

Favor is an expression of God's love!

You don't have to settle for a "God, can I really have it?" mentality. God has a whole new level He wants to bring you to, and His favor will take you there!
